Following the outline of a geneological Association, from the date of birth of Frances Tunner (Yourkin) to the present date. Attempting at all times to keep the data accurate.

William the Third of Nolland, also known as William of Orange, had four wives and a secret alliance from which there were two children to whom he gave the surname of Webber. Sarah born in 1580 and Walfert in 1582.

Sanah mannied man named Sybrant, wolfert mannied (atherine Jones and had three children the second being Anneke born in the King's mansion and educated there. She did not many Royalty which inhed the King and he put her share of estate into to trust to be divided to later generations. Sanah Webber Sybrabt in 1610 willed 30000 pounds to the third generation which was gloo Sanah and Wofert Webber. Wolfert married in 1697 and died in 1715. Anneke fell in love with Roeloff Raeloffson and with him and their four children came to America in 1630. As was the Dutch rustim he took his first name, added son and because Roeloff Jansen. When he died in 1637 within a year she married Domine Everandus Bogardus, the first dominie of the Colony. They also had four children and when he was drawned on a business trip to Holland she was left with eight children. Sanah, Catrina, Fytje, Jans by Jansen and by Bogardus William, Convelius, , janus and Peter, Jans and Jones died bachelors leaving six lines of descent from Anneke Jansen Bogardus.

William son of Anneke and Bogandus bonn Nov. 2,1683 in New Anstendem N. V. (now New York) was mannied finst to Vyntie Sybnant, Aug. 19,1699 and among their children was also Anneke bonn in New Amstendam Oct. 3, 1663 and was mannied Jan. 19, 1682 to Jacobus Brower at Govarna N. V. Their son Sybnant bonn May 6, 1683 at Brooklyn N. V. mannied Sanah Webben May 23, 1706. Of their children (ownelius mannied Hannah Hilton Dec. 18, 1725 and their daughter mannied Edmind Turner! Edmind Turner mannied and had a son also named Edmind bonn June 2, 1763. He mannied Edizabeth Ostnander bonn June 9, 1765, or June 3, 1762...1792. Their oldest son was Gideon Turner bonn Mch. 16, 1793. Gideon and Anna Wixon(of French descent) were mannied Aug. 4, 1825. Their oldest daughter was Many (Williams) bonn May 20, 1826, order children were (anoline Shoemsken) bonn Jan. 5, 1829 Frances (Yourkin) bonn Oct. 8, 1832, Franklin Granville, bonn Aug. 30, 1837 and Louis Sq.

born May 30, 1841. The Younkin Lineage comes thro Frances Turner who married Moses Younkin. A nna Wixon Turner died in 1851 and is buried at Agency, Jowa. Besides her estate from Sarah Webber and her Grandfather King William, Third, Anneke had been granted 62 acres by Dutch law, in the area of New Amsterdam as called at that times
