

The following family information was researched and compiled by Thomas A. Wilhoff of Indianapolis, Ind. and published in 1924. The later list of kinship by generations was completed by Fernie Beaman Smith in 1966. Following the outline of a genealogical Association, from the date of birth of Frances Tunnen (Younkin) to the present date. Attempting at all times to keep the data accurate.

William the Third of Holland, also known as William of Orange, had four wives and a secret alliance from which there were two children to whom he gave the surname of Webber. Sarah born in 1580 and Wolfert in 1582.

Sarah married man named Sybrant, Wolfert married Catherine Jonas and had three children the second being Anneke born in the King's mansion and educated there. She did not marry Royalty which irked the King and he put her share of estate into a trust to be divided to later generations. Sarah Webber Sybrant in 1610 willed 30000 pounds to the third generation which was also Sarah and Wolfert Webber. Wolfert married in 1697 and died in 1715. Anneke fell in love with Roeloff Raeloffson and with him and their four children came to America in 1630. As was the Dutch custom he took his first name, added son and became Roeloff Jansen. When he died in 1637 within a year she married Dominie Everardus Bogardus, the first dominie of the Colony. They also had four children and when he was drowned on a business trip to Holland she was left with eight children. Sarah, Catrina, Fytje, Jans by Jansen and by Bogardus William, Cornelius, Jonas and Peter. Jans and Jonas died bachelors leaving six lines of descent from Anneke Jansen Bogardus.

William son of Anneke and Bogardus born Nov. 2, 1683 in New Amsterdam N.Y. (now New York) was married first to Wynkie Sybrant, Aug. 19, 1659 and among their children was also Anneke born in New Amsterdam Oct. 3, 1663 and was married Jan. 19, 1682 to Jacobus Brouwer at Gowanus N.Y. Their son Sybrant born May 6, 1683 of Brooklyn N.Y. married Sarah Webber May 23, 1706. Of their children Cornelius married Hannah Hilton Dec. 18, 1725 and their daughter married Edmund Tunnen/ Edmund Turner married and had a son also named Edmund born June 2, 1763. He married Elizabeth Ostrander born June 9, 1765, on June 3, 1763-1792. Their oldest son was Gideon Tunnen born Mich. 16, 1793. Gideon and Anna Wilson (of French descent) were married Aug. 4, 1825. Their oldest daughter was Mary (Williams) born May 20, 1826, other children were Caroline (Shoemaker) born Jan. 5, 1829 Frances (Younkin) born Oct. 8, 1832, Franklin Greenville, born Aug. 30, 1837 and Louis Gg.

born May 30, 1841. The Younkin lineage comes thro Frances Turner who married Moses Younkin. A nna Wixon Turner died in 1851 and is buried at Agency, Iowa. Besides her estate from Sarah Webber and her Grandfather King William, Third, Anneke had been granted 62 acres by Dutch law, in the area of New Amsterdam as called at that time.
